Officer involved shooting in southwest Minot

At approximately 7:30 a.m., officers from the Minot Police Department were dispatched to a residence in southwest Minot following a reported domestic disturbance.

Minot Central Dispatch had received a call with sounds of an argument between a male and a female. During the call, dispatch overheard threats of using a firearm

Minot Police officers responded to the scene. As the incident unfolded, two officers discharged their department-issued firearms. The male involved in the reported domestic disturbance was struck and pronounced deceased at the scene.

Following protocol, involved officers have been placed on administrative leave and the North Dakota Bureau of Criminal Investigation (BCI) has taken over the investigation.
